## Gradient Blanket & Jacket Easy Crochet

#### MEASUREMENTS

Blanket - Size (approx) 70 x 70 cm Jacket - To fit 3-9 months (approx)

YARN (We suggest using the yarn stated to acheive the style pictured) Plassard TRADI MERINO 50g x 4 balls Main Colour (M) for Blanket and 1 hall for Jacket.

Laines Du Nord PAINT GRADIENT SOCK 100g x 1 ball Contrast Colour (C) for both Blanket and Jacket.

## HOOKS AND EXTRAS

A 4.50mm crochet hook, or size needed to give correct tension. Stitch marker, Wool needle. 3 buttons for Jacket.

TENSION Take the time to ensure your tension is correct 14 rounds of pattern = 10 cm x 10 cm, using 4.50mm hook.

#### ABBREVIATIONS (UK Terms)

approx = approximate, beg = begin/ning, ch = chain, cm = centimetres, cont = continue, dc = double crochet, ea = each, patt = pattern, rep = repeat. RS = right side, sk = skip, sp = space, ss = slip stitch, sm = stitch marker, st/s = stitch/es, tog = together, tr = treble, WS = wrong

#### SPECIAL NOTES

Projects are worked in the round DO NOT TURN WORK. When working C round keep M at the back of work using a stitch marker through loop to hold it secure.

Fasten off C at the end of each round.

#### BLANKET

Using 4.50mm hook and M, ch4, join with ss to 1st ch to make circle. 1st round - into ch circle ch3, tr2, ch1, \* (tr3, ch1) rep from \* 2 more times, ss to 3rd ch of beg ch, place sm.

2nd round - Join C into cnr ch sp, dc1, \* ch3, sk3, into cnr ch sp, dc1, ch3, dc1, rep from \* 2 more times, dc1, ch3, ss to 1st dc made. Fasten off.

3rd round - Using M, remove sm, into cnr 3ch sp of previous round, ch3, tr2, \* into ea 3ch sp tr3 to cnr ch sp, tr3, ch1, tr3, rep from \* 3 more times, into last cnr ch sp tr3, ch1, ss to 3rd ch of beg ch.

4th round - Join C into cnr ch sp, dc1, \* ch3, sk3, into next ch sp, dc1, rep from \* to cnr ch sp, dc1, ch3, dc1, rep this sequence to last cnr ch sp dc1, ch3, ss to 1st dc made. Fasten off.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rounds until 4 balls of M have been used or desired size, ending with a 2nd round. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Sew in ends.

## JACKET BODY AND SLEEVES (make 2)

Using 4.50mm hook and M ch5, join with ss to 1st ch to make circle. 1st round - into ch circle ch3, tr2, ch1, \* (tr3, ch1) rep from \* 4 more times, ss to 3rd ch of beg ch, place sm.

2nd round - Join C into cnr ch sp, dc1, \* ch3, sk3, into cnr ch sp, dc1, ch3, dc1, rep from \* 5 more times, dc1, ch3, ss to 1st dc made. Fasten off.

3rd round - Using M, remove sm, into cnr 3ch sp of previous round, ch3, tr2, \* into ea 3ch sp tr3 to cnr ch sp, tr3, ch1, tr3, rep from \* 5 more times, into last cnr ch sp tr3, ch1, ss to 3rd ch of beg ch.

4th round - Join C into cnr ch sp, dc1, \* ch3, sk3, into sp between group of 3 tr, dc1, rep from \* to cnr ch sp, dc1, ch3, dc1, rep this sequence to last cnr ch sp dc1, ch3, ss to 1st dc made. Fasten off.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rounds 5 more times, then 3rd round once.

Fasten off.

#### Joining and Edges

With RS facing, fold each completed body and sleeve piece so that when placed next to each other they make a jacket.

Holding centre backs WS together, beginning at neck edge join in C to the piece facing you - dc1 in cnr ch sp, ss in opposite cnr ch sp, ch2, \* in next sp between groups of tr3, dc1, ss in opposite sp between groups of tr3, ch2, rep from \* 11 more times (2 groups of tr3 before cnr ch sp of lower edge), dc1, ss in opposite sp, continuing around lower edge of jacket ch2, dc1, in next sp, ch3, \*\* into cnr ch sp dc1, ch1, dc1, ch3, sk3, dc1 (in sp between groups of tr3) ch3, rep from \*\* to cnr ch sp of front edge, dc1, ch1, dc1, then rep from \*\* to cnr ch sp of neck edge, dc1, ch1, dc1, rep from \*\* working over 2 more groups of tr3. DO NOT fasten off.

Continue to join right SLEEVE SEAM rep from \* 11 times to sleeve edge, ch1, dc1 to complete cnr ch sp \* ch1, dc1 in next sp, rep from \* to cnr ch sp of sleeve edge, ch1, dc1, ss to dc. Fasten off.

With RS facing (WS together) join C to top ch sp cnr of left sleeve edge, dc1, ch1, dc1, then dc1, ch1 as before for right sleeve edge, to last cnr ch sp, dc1, ch1, dc1, ss to 1st dc made. DO NOT fasten off. Continue to join left SLEEVE SEAM, rep from \* ie. ch2, dc1 in next sp, ss in opposite sp, 11 times, then continue around neck edge, front edge and lower edge to the beginning at centre back, rep from \*\* ie ch3, dc1 in ea sp to cnr ch sp, dc1, ch1, dc1, ss. Fasten off.

#### Right Front Flap

With RS facing, join in M to 1st 3ch sp, work groups of tr3 up right front to last 3ch sp, Fasten off.


With RS facing, join in C to 1ch sp of previous (C) contrast row, ch2, dc1 in 1 st tr, ch2, rep from \*\* to last 3tr group, ch2, dc1 in last tr, ch2, ss to cnr ch sp of previous C row. Fasten off.

Left Front Flap and RS facing, join M at NECK EDGE and work 2 rows as for Right Front Flap. Fasten off.

Complete back NECK EDGE, join C to 1st dc of right sleeve seam, ch3, dc1 in sp between 3tr groups to centre back seam, dc1 on either side of dc of centre back seam, then complete left neck edge to Left sleeve seam, ss to seam. Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Sew in ends. Sew on buttons and fasten through fabric to wear.



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
