MOONSHINE

Worked flat in two pieces then seamed, Moonshine makes this top a quick pleasure to knit, and the mesh openwork fabric is perfect for layering.

SIZES

X-Small (Small, Medium, Large, X-Large, 2X-Large, 3X-Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Finished bust circumference: 32 (36, 40, 44, 48, 52, 56)"/81.25 (91.5, 101.5, 111.75, 122, 132, 142.25)cm.

Length from hem to neck: 21½ (22½, 23¼, 24, 24¾, 25½, 26)"/54.5 (57.25, 59, 61, 62.75, 64.75, 66)cm.

YARN & NOTIONS

3 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 6) x 100g skeins of Juniper Moon Farm **Moonshine** in color 50 Peppercorn.

Size US 10 (6mm) 24"/61cm –or longer– circular needle (to accommodate a large number of stitches.)

Tapestry needle.

GAUGE

12 sts x 24 rows = 4"/10cm in Mesh Lace.

NOTES

Top is worked in two identical pieces from the bottom up. Mesh Lace row gauge is closer to a Garter stitch gauge due to the fabric's internal bias.

GLOSSARY

2x2 Ribbing (multiples of 4 sts + 2)

Row 1 (RS): *K2, p2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2 (WS): *P2, k2; repeat from * to last 2 sts, p2.

Mesh Lace (even number of sts, worked flat)

Row 1 (RS): Yo, (k2tog, yo) to last 2 sts, k2tog.

Rows 2 & 4 (WS): Purl all sts.

Row 3 (RS): K1, (yo, k2tog) to last st, k1.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm	centimeters	RS	right side
CO	cast on	st(s)	stitch(es)
k	knit	tog	together
mm	millimeters	WS	wrong side
p	purl	yo	yarn over

BODY (MAKE TWO)

CO 50 (54, 62, 66, 74, 78, 86) sts. Work back and forth in 2x2 Ribbing until piece measures 3 (3½, 3¾, 4, 4¼, 4½, 4½)"/7.5 (9, 9.5, 10, 10.75, 11.5, 11.5)cm from CO edge.

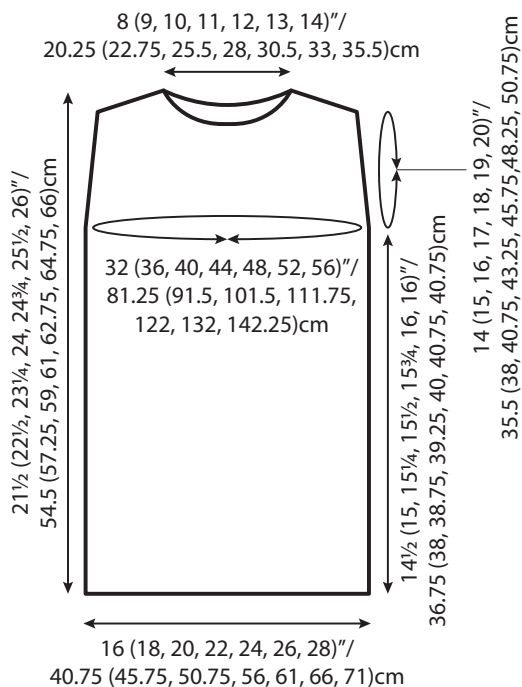
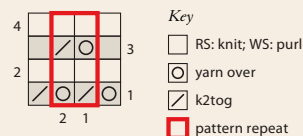
Set-up Row (RS): K1, work Mesh Lace over 46 (50, 58, 62, 70, 74, 82) sts, k1.

Keeping first and last st in Garter St for selvedge, work in Mesh Lace until piece measures 21½ (22½, 23¼, 24, 24¾, 25½, 26)"/54.5 (57.25, 59, 61, 62.75, 64.75, 66)cm from CO edge, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

With WS facing, seam up sides beginning at CO edge, use mattress st for seaming up 14½ (15, 15¼, 15½, 15¾, 16, 16)"/36.75 (38, 38.75, 39.25, 40, 40.75, 40.75)cm on each side. Beginning at outer edge of each shoulder, seam along shoulder 4 (4½, 5, 5½, 6, 6½, 7)"/10 (11.5, 12.75, 13.75, 15.25, 16.5, 17.75) cm towards neck. Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.
