

HALF AND HALF

Designed by Sandi Rosner

Like a beautiful math problem worked with short rows (40 triangles inside 20 rectangles inside 4 strips), everything about the half and half blanket adds up just right.

• EASY

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approximately 50 x 40 "/127 x 101.5cm.

MATERIALS

- 8 x 1¾oz/50g skeins (each approx 110yd/100m) of Noro Kureyon (wool) each in #416 Ena (A) and #395 Numata (B).
- One size US 8 (5mm) circular needle, 32"/80cm long, *or size to obtain gauge*.

GAUGE

16 sts and 30 rows over garter st using size US 8 (5mm) needle. TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm centimeters; g grams; k knit; LH left-hand; m meters; mm millimeters; oz ounces; p purl; rem remain(ing); rep repeat;
RH right-hand; RS right side; sl slip; st(s) stitch(es); tog together; WS wrong side; yd yards.

NOTE

Blanket is worked in rows. Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of sts for borders. Do not join.

SHORT ROW WRAP & TURN (w&t)

- 1) SI next st purlwise to RH needle.
- 2) Move yarn between needles to front.
- 3) Return sl st to LH needle, then turn work—1 st is wrapped.
- 4) When working the wrapped st, insert RH needle under the wrap and work it tog with corresponding st on needle.

BLANKET


Panel (make 4) With A, cast on 50 sts. Row 1 (WS) Knit. Row 2 (RS) Knit to last 2 sts, w&t. Row 3 Knit to end of row. **Row 4** Knit to 2 sts before last wrapped st, w&t. Row 5 Knit to end of row. **Rows 6–49** Rep rows 4 and 5 twenty-two times more. Row 50 (RS) Knit to end of row. **Row 51** K1, k2tog, k to last st, M1, k1. Change to B. Row 52 (RS) Knit. **Row 53** K1, k2tog, k to last st, M1, k1. Row 54 Knit. Row 55 K2, w&t. Row 56 Knit to end of row. **Row 57** Knit to wrapped st, knit wrapped st, k1, w&t. Row 58 Knit to end of row. Rows 59–102 Rep rows 57 and 58 twenty-two times more. Row 103 Knit to end of row. Change to A. Row 104 (RS) Knit. Rep rows 1–104 three times more. Rep rows 1–103 once more. Bind off all sts.


FINISHING

Arrange panels as shown in assembly diagram and sew tog.

Border

With RS facing and A, pick up and k 260 sts along one side edge, picking up 1 st in each garter ridge.
Knit 1 row. Bind off loosely.
Work in same way along other side edge.
With RS facing and A, pick up and k 200 sts along cast-on edge.
Knit 1 row. Bind off loosely.
Work in same way along bound-off edge.
Sew edges of border tog at each corner.
Weave in ends. Block to finished measurements.•





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
